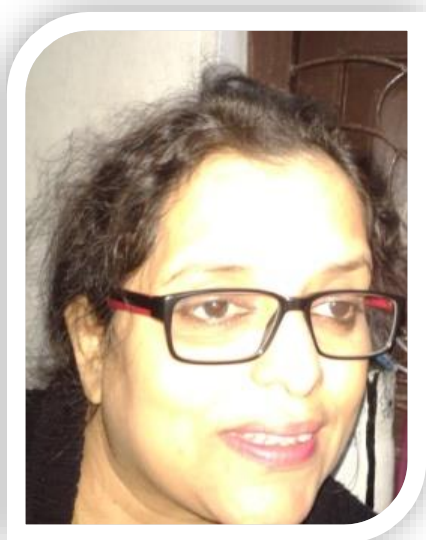

From the Writing Table (2021-22)-





In the fag-end of his life he has dedicated himself in the service of mankind during the terrible outburst of Covid-19 pandemic.

As recognition of his spirited effort, leadership, holistic & comprehensive service towards persons with disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, awarded the National Award to ABHOY MISSION in 2018.

We have lost our friend, philosopher and guide. But if we distract ourselves from the path paved by him, it will aptly be a dishonor to him. ABHOY MISSION strongly vows to continue its function on the path cemented by Late Shyamal Deb. We are determined to go forward with our Mission and Vision.

Activities for Senior Citizens

In the year 2021-22 activities of ABHOY MISSION for senior citizens were carried out in diversified ways -

- A. Rehabilitation Centre for Senior Citizens (Old Age Home) - Abhoy Ashram.
- B. Community Based Rehabilitation for Senior Citizens.
- C. Rehabilitation of Senior citizens through helpline and Counseling Centre.

Rehabilitation Centre for Senior Citizen (Old Age Home)- 'Abhoy Ashram'

“Abhoy Ashram”, a Rehabilitation Centre for poor & shelter less elderly, commenced its work in the year 1993 to provide round the clock care by the qualified & skillful service givers. Beneficiaries are being enrolled in the centre with reference of Social Welfare & Social Education Department, District Legal Services Authority, Gram Panchayats, and Tripura Commission for Women & Tripura Police.

Reinstatement of happiness and healthy sensation in elderly, who have no refuge & custodian in their family, from physical, psychological and social point of view, is the focal point of the program.

Service in different areas like healthcare, nutrition, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, recreation is being provided to enrolled senior citizens. Arrangement of ambulance, cold water plant, hot water plant, water purifier and solar power plant is there in the Home to provide 24 hours smooth and effective service in a day.

In Abhoy Ashram, there is a Home Care Team consisting of Doctor, Nurse, Counselor, Geriatric Animator, Physiotherapist, Yoga Therapist, Dietician and volunteers. The Home Care Team provides the care to the Elderly people, such as home making, companionship, ADL help, counseling, giving medicines, basic physiotherapy, dietary service, checking vitals, arranging laboratory tests and communicating with health professionals. The Home Care Team gives lifelong care to the elderly people residing in the Ashram.

With view to providing comfortable facilities to the Elderly People, there is three-storied building with Bathroom facility. Wooden cots with standard quality bedding are provided for each beneficiary. Care givers are deployed in each room for 24 hours watch. Moreover, there is separate sick room for sick beneficiary. There is a temple in the Ashram premises for providing spiritual facility to the beneficiaries. Most of musical instruments are given to them for performing Kirtan etc. There is well equipped physiotherapy Unit in the Ashram. Besides these, Yoga training is imparted to the beneficiaries everyday by an expert yoga trainer. As a result, most of the elderly people are enjoying a happy life.

To keep the elderly persons well from psyche point of view, the beneficiaries are facilitated to take opportunities to involve themselves in community and social programs. They get occupied themselves in observation of Chaitra Sankranti, New Years Day,

Akshay Tritiya, Buddha Purnima, Rabindra Jayanti, Rathayatra, Manasamangal, Manasa Puja, Independence Day, Laxmi Puja, Diwali, Kali puja, Bhatridwitiya, Makar Sangranti, Republic Day Saraswati Puja, Shiva Chaturdashi, Dolyatra and Holi Festival. They visited pandals during Durga Puja Festival.

International Older Person's Day

On 1st October, International Older Day was celebrated with full enthusiasm in Abhoy Ashram. At morning, a Health camp was organized by the ABHOY MISSION in collaboration with Madhupur PHC. Blood Sugar test, Hemoglobin Test and Blood Pressure Test done with medical checkup by the medical officers. Medicine was also provided to beneficiaries accordingly. Later, on evening a program was organized by all the children and old age people in presence of the President, Secretary & Executive Members of ABHOY MISSION, Chief Superintendent of Abhoy Ashram and other officials. At the starting of the program, all the old age persons were felicitated with sandal paste on their forehead. The children and staff performed a group dance and song to offer love and respect for elderly grans. Then a dance drama was perfored by an elderly gran, Secretary of the organization and Superintendent of Old Age Home which was mesmerizing to watch. Then a gran Smt Chhaya Bhattacharjee spoke about her life history in front of the dignitary and thanks Secretary Madam to rescuing her from a very bad condition and providing a safe warm place to stay for rest of her life. In the end of the day sweets were distributed among all the beneficiaries of Abhoy Ashram.

Community Based Rehabilitation to Senior Citizens

CBR with support from Help Age India

With support from Help Age India, ABHOY MISSION has been working in (Community Based Rehabilitation Program CBR) for poor old people through 'Adopt A Gran' (AAG) project since 2003.

Making realistic for countryside senior citizens to stay alive with esteem within their families is the most noteworthy objective of the program. On the basis of discussion and necessity of beneficiaries, food grains, clothes, garments, mosquito nets, pocket money etc. are provided to 26 aged parents.



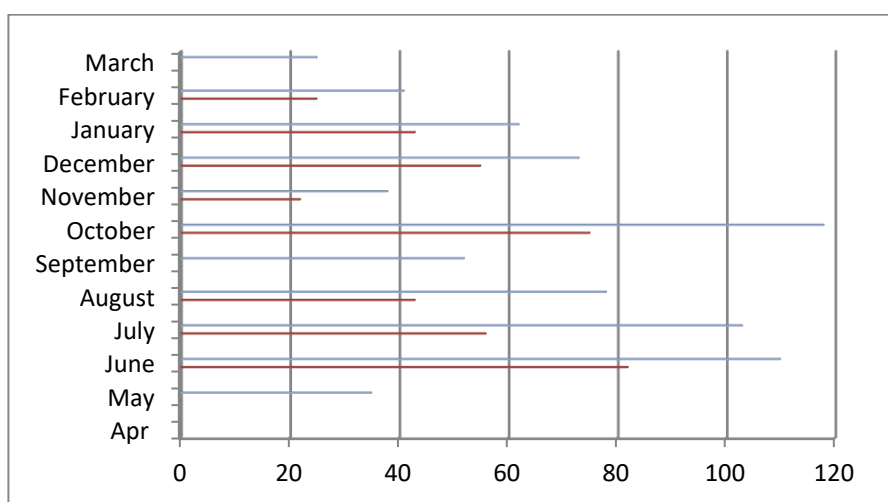
CBR with support from Give India

Give India, a donation platform for providing gracious support all through the country, is providing fundamental support to elderly citizens in Tripura. We communicate our high regards to Give India.

Reinstatement of good emotional and social life form in old people in rural areas through support in the sector of nutrition, physical condition, hygiene and encouraging autonomy are the most significant purposes of the program.

CBR support is being provided through two package i.e., @Rs.900/- and @Rs.525/-.

Ration & toiletries per month are given to elderly people as a means of raising standard of living and removal of feeling of considering self as burden in the family. Grant for medical expenses is included in those packages. Month-wise support provided to number of elderly people in different months of 2021-22 has been shown in Fig 1

Activities for Development of Persons with Disabilities

In the year 2021-22, the dealings for development of children and young with disabilities were as follows-

- A. Swabalamban Special School for Children with Multiple and Intellectual Disabilities

- E. Training program for different sections of community in association with the National Institute for Mentally Handicapped.
- F. State Nodal Agency Centre (SNAC), Tripura State under National Trust

Swabalamban Special School for Children with Multiple and Intellectual Disabilities

The foremost special school, for children with intellectual disabilities, in Tripura, the 'Swabalamban' commenced its service on 26th January, 1991. Students are passing through teaching learning course in this school. The school is positioned in Gakulnagar Gram Panchayat under Bishalgarh R.D. Block.

The underlying principle behind the mission is to offer education to the children with multiple and intellectual disabilities through dealing with their individual strength & needs.

The effort is busy with individual education program and monitoring system with the help of adapted equipments and resources.

Training to develop personal skills including daily living skills, social, academic & occupational skills are provided to children with special needs. Besides, training in Arts, Music, Dance and prevocational training is being provided to them. Children are being encouraged to acquire skills in sports & games.

Community Based Rehabilitation for children with disabilities through support from Give India

In the year 2021-22, capacity building in residence and dietary support are being provided to children with multiple disabilities. Children were supported through per month donation option of Rs.500/- & Rs.125/-.

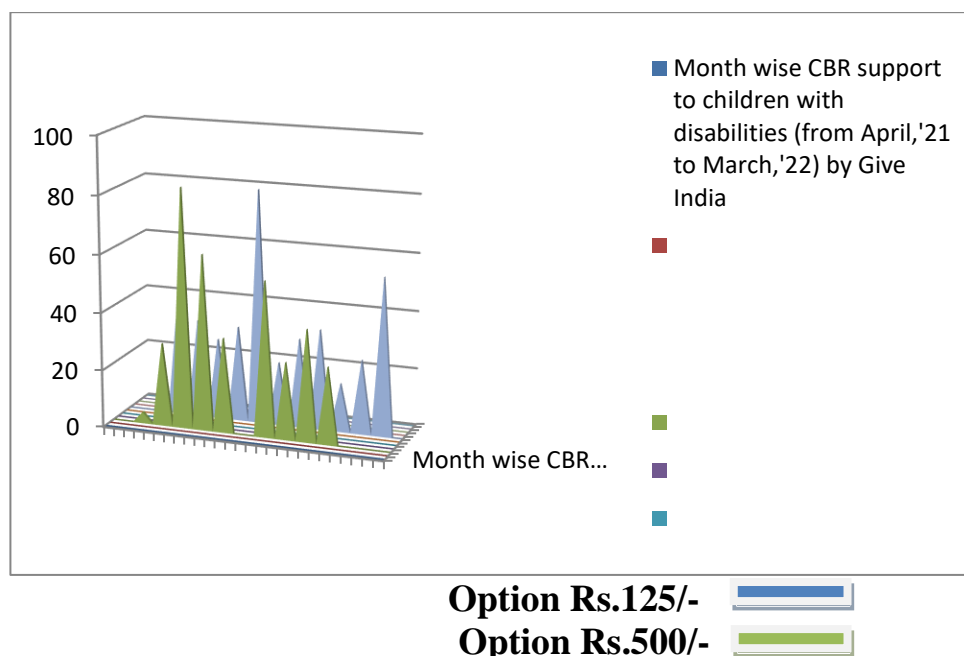


Fig 2. Month wise CBR support (from April, 2021 to March, 2022) to children with disabilities from Give India.

Swabalamban Rehabilitation Centre for Children with Special needs

Conforming to the provisions & policy of Child Protection Service (CPS) scheme under Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. of India, Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, ABHOY MISSION is running a Child Care Institution (CCI) under the nomenclature of 'Swabalamban Rehabilitation Centre for children with special needs' in Gakulnagar GP of Bishalgarh Sub-divisional area. Accessibility to care & protection for children with special needs, especially orphan, in protected setting is the rationale of the program.

The CCI is recognized by the Government of Tripura, Directorate of Social welfare & Social Education with Registration No.03 under Juvenile Justice Act, 2015.

Girls and boys, within the age range of 6-18 years are enrolled in the CCI with appropriate order & recommendation of Child Welfare Committee of any District of Tripura State. Total seat capacity is 50. On the concluding day of financial year 2021-22, there were 55 enrolled children in the Rehabilitation Centre. Around three-fifth(35) of them have been enrolled in normal inclusive school.

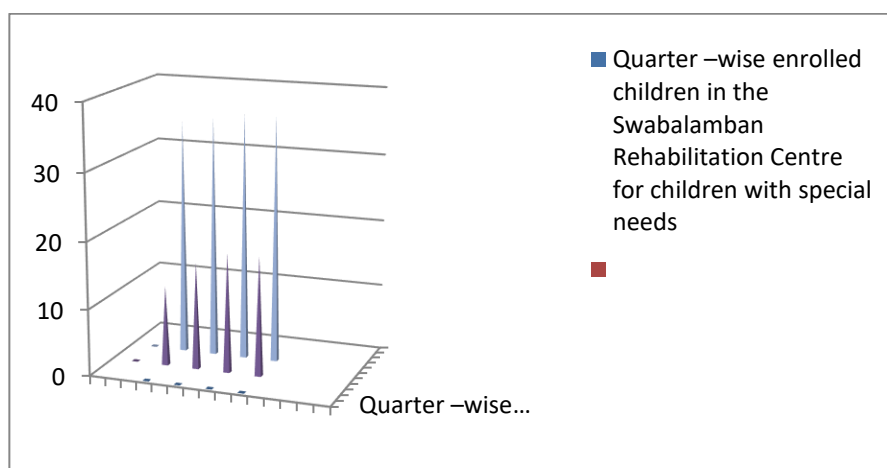
The centre, on the basis of existing level of individual abilities of special need children, provides following services and facilities-

- i) Health Care facilities together with physiotherapy service, nutrition, emotional care,
- ii) education for developing personal skills, social, academic & occupational skills,
- iii) pre-vocational & vocational training, iv) amusement activities.

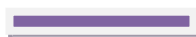
All facilities act in concert with the service from competent personnel for smooth progress in all round development in the children.

Children are encouraged to participate in diverse programs. Within Swabalamban Rehabilitation Centre the children observed Independence Day, Republic Day, National Teachers Day, International Yoga Day, Laxmi Puja, Bhatridwitia, Manasa Puja and other Social Festival.

Girls are denoted by



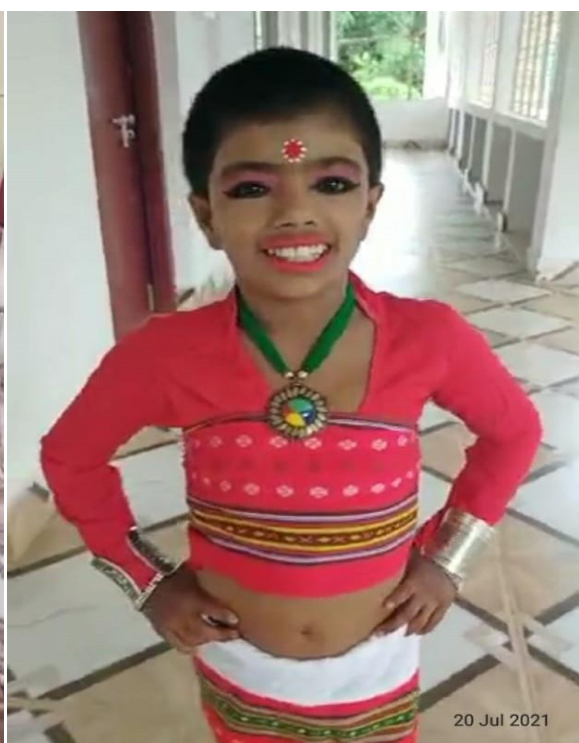
Fig 3. Number of enrolled children with special needs in Rehabilitation Centre in 2021-22.





5th North East India Traditional Fashion Week

The children with special needs of Swabalamban Rehabilitation Centre participated in Traditional Dance, Ramp walk and textile training & art exhibition. All the performance was highly appreciated by the program officials and officials of Ministry.



Pan India Awareness & Outreach Campaign.

National Legal Services Authority organized Pan India Awareness & Outreach Campaign as a part of “Azadi ka Amrit Mhotsav” from 2nd October, 2021 to 14th November, 2021. Hon’ble Chief Justice of India, Justice N.V. Ramana and Hon’ble Union Minister for Women and Child Development, Smriti Zubin Irani graced the chair of Chief Guest and Guest of Honour. Hon’ble Justice Uday Umesh Lalit also graced the chair of Guest of Honour. The children with special needs of Swabalamban Rehabilitation Centre participated in the valedictory program and performed dance in the valedictory session held in Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on 14th November, 2021.

The children from Swabalamban Rehabilitation center for children with special needs were invited to perform a group dance at High court of Tripura on 6th November, 2021. Hon’ble Justice of Supreme Court, Uday Umesh Lalit, Chief Justice of High court of Tripura, Justice Indrajit Mohanty and other judges of High Court of Tripura were present in the program. On the basis of performance of the children they were invited to perform in the valedictory program of Pan India Awareness & Outreach Campaign held in New Delhi.



Battle against COVID 19

The year 2021-22, like previous year, was harshly hit by the COVID 19 virus. To protect elderly in the Old Age Home and special need children in Child Care Institution, located in Abhoy Ashram area, from this deadly virus, several measures were taken as per COVID 19 Guideline.

On 19th May, 2021, by the instruction of Directorate of Social Welfare and Social Education, Govt. of Tripura and Child Welfare Committee, Sepahijala District the old beneficiaries, every child and office staffs of Abhoy Ashram went under Reverse transcription polymerase chain reaction test (RT-PCR) for Corona virus. And by the blessings of almighty every individuals were tested negative in the test report came at 21st May, 2021.

By the effort of District Inspector of Child protection, Sepahijala District it is being possible to get prepared a camp inside the Abhoy Ashram on 15th June, 2021. In the camp all the Children Home beneficiaries who were 18 years or above had get vaccinated by 1st dose of Covisheild vaccine for protection from infection of Corona virus.

By March, 2022, all the elderly beneficiaries and all enrolled special need children of above 18 years age group, in CCI, received 2nd dose of Covisheild vaccine. By this time period, all the enrolled children of CCI, within the age range of 15-18 years, received 1st dose of COVID vaccine.

CBR with support from GIVE INDIA in respect of COVID 19

With guidance and support from Give India, ABHOY MISSION took several activities to assist the elderly and divyanjan of Tripura State who fell in misery due to COVID 19 affected situation. Founder President of the organization late Shyamal Deb took special initiative to implement the programs.

Awariness Cum Nutritional Kits Distribution under Dukli RD Block

The distribution of nutrition and sanitization materials was organized by the ABHOY MISSION at areas of Suryamaninagar Gram Panchayet and Chowmuhani Bazar Gram Panchayet on 28th August, 2021. The program was conducted in the presence of Secretary Abhoy Mission Miss Susmita De, Sabhadipati Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad Mrs Antara Sarkar Deb and pradhans of gram panchayet of those areas. This support was provided among 71 nos. of beneficiaries of that area.

Awariness Cum Nutritional Kits Distribution under Nalchar RD Block

On 03/10/2021, at Nalchar RD Block, a camp was organized by taking people from various Gram Panchayets nearby. The camp was coordinated by Miss Susmita De, Secretary ABHOY MISSION. Hon'ble Sabhadipati of Sepahijala Zilla Parishad Smt. Supriya Das Dutta, Chief Superintendent of Abhoy Ashram Miss Supriya De, Renowned social worker Sri Pijush Das and Pradhans from various Gram Panchayts were present in

the program. A total of 61 beneficiaries, from different Gram Panchayats like Purva Durlavnarayan G.P., Paschim Durlav narayan G.P. & Bagabasa G.P. attended the Distribution camp. **Nutritional kits, Sanitization materials and Rs. 500/- for purchase of perishable goods and medicine as per their requirement distributed individual wise.**

Awariness Cum Nutritional Kits Distribution under Boxanagar RD Block

On 3rd October, 2021, distribution to COVID19 affected families was done at Boxanagar Block area in the presence of dignitaries like Hon'ble Sabhadhipati of Sepahijala District, Smt. Supriya Das Dutta, Secretary of ABHOY MISSION Smt. Susmita De, Chief Superintendent of Abhoy Ashram Miss Supriya De, and pradhans of the gram panchayets under this block. A total of 20 nos. of beneficiaries from Anandapur Gram Panchayet attended the camp, to whom nutritional & sanitization

Nutritional kits and Rs. 500/- for purchase of perishable goods and medicine as per their need distributed.

Awariness Cum Nutritional Kits Distribution under Boxanagar RD Block

On 29-08-2020, awareness as well as distribution of nutrition program was conducted in Veluarchar and Kalshimura GP under Boxanagar RD Block. In total 40 families were benefitted from the program.

Awariness Cum Nutritional Kits Distribution under Mohanpur RD Block

At Mohanpur RD Block area of West Tripura District on 27th October, 2021, a distribution camp near Mohinipur GP was arranged. The total number of 132 beneficiaries attended this distribution program to take support. Elderly from Kalacharra GP, Mohinipur GP, Bijoynagar GP and Rangacharra GP under Mohanpur RD Block participated in the program. The camp was coordinated by the Secretary of Abhoy Mission, Miss Susmita De, Chief Superintendent of Abhoy Ashram Miss Supriya De in the presence of the Sabhadipati of Paschim Zilla Parishad, Smt Antara Deb Sarkar and Various functionaries of Panchayet Raj system of that area. A very beautiful program was initiated by celebrating International Older person day.

Awareness cum Distribution of Nutrition materials in cooperation with Paschim Tripura Zila Parishad

With cooperation from Paschim Tripura Zila Parishad, ABHOY MISSION, organized Awareness cum Distribution of nutrition materials in different parts of West Tripura District.

Awareness cum Distribution of nutrition materials in Dukli RD Block

On 8th April, 2021, the program was organized in Sekerkote Gram Panchayet area. Smt Antara Deb Sarkar, the Hon'ble Sabhadipati, Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad, late Shyamal Deb, the then President of Abhoy Mission, Sri Premangshu Chakraborty, Executive Member of Abhoy Mission, various Panchayet functionaries and volunteers from the local community were present in the program. **76 nos.** of beneficiaries were selected by a group of volunteers of the community under the leadership of Smt Aparna Sen, Chairman of Social Justice Standing Committee of Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad.

On 8th April, 2021 program was held in Bikramnagar Panchayet and its surrounding areas. Nutrition materials and sanitization materials were distributed within **33** beneficiaries from poverty stricken families.

On 17th April, 2021, ABHOY MISSION organized Awareness cum Distribution program and Medical camp at Kalidaspara and Jarulbachai ADC village. Smt Antara Deb Sarkar, Sabhadipati, Sri Hari Dulal Acharjee, Saha Sabhadipati of Pachim Tripura Zilla Parishad, late Shyamal Deb, the then President of Abhoy Mission and other representatives from the panchayets & community were present in the program. 27 nos. of families were benefitted through this program.

On 17th April, 2021, awareness cum distribution program was held at Ramkrishna Mission of Anandanagar area. Smt Antara Deb Sarkar, Sabhadipati, Sri Hari Dulal Acharjee, Saha Sabhadipati of Pachim Tripura Zilla Parishad, late Shyamal Deb, the then President of Abhoy Mission and other representative panchayets from the community were present in the program. There were total **40 nos.** of beneficiaries came to take nutritional as well as sanitization kit.

ABHOY MISSION structured awareness cum distribution campaign on 17th April, 2021 in association with Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad in front of an Anganwadi Center of Ramgati Para under Srinagar Gram Pachayet. In total 18 Nos. of beneficiaries were attended the program.

Awareness cum Distribution of nutrition materials in Bamutia RD Block

ABHOY MISSION, in association with Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad, structured awareness cum distribution campaign on 12th April, 2021 in the areas of Patunagar, Durjoynagar, Nutunnagar and Dighaliya Gram Panchayets. The nutritional and sanitization items were distributed to 42 Nos. of beneficiaries. The program was conducted in the presence of the Hon'ble Saha Sabhadipati of Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad Sri Hari Dulal Acharjee, then President of Abhoy Mission late Shyamal Deb, and functionaries of three tier panchayet system

On 12th April, 2021 the awareness cum distribution program was organized in Ananganagar Gram Panchayet office premises with an aim of elevating level of awareness on hygiene and health care and distributing nutritional support kits to the elderly and special needs people, belonging to poverty stricken families. Total **63 Nos.** of elderly and divyangjan people from Ananganagar and Singerbill G.P. were present the program to take benefit from it. Sri Hari Dulal Acharjee Hon'ble Saha Sabhadipati, Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad, late Shyamal Deb, the then President of Abhoy Mission, and functionaries of three tiers Panchayeti Raj system attended the program.

On 13th April, 2021 the program was organized in Berimura Community Hall near Berimura HS School premises. Distribution of nutritional support kits to the elderly and special needs people, belonging to poverty stricken families was taken place. **Total 48** Nos. of elderly and divyangjan people from Berimura, Purba Bamutia and Paschim Bamutia G.P. were present in the program to take benefit from it.

The program was structured by ABHOY MISSION in Kashipur village under Ishanchandrapur GP on 18th April, 2021. Nutritional materials and Sanitization kit were

distributed among **75 Nos.** of beneficiaries in the program. The program was organized in the presence of Sabhdipati of Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad Smt Antara Deb Sarkar and then Abhoy Mission President late Shyamal Deb with all other functionaries of panchayet system.

Awareness cum Distribution of nutrition materials in Jirania RD Block

The program was organized in Ramkrishna Mission Ashram of Mohanpur on 18th April, 2021. Nutritional materials and Sanitization kit were distributed among 20 Nos. of beneficiaries in the program. Sabhdipati of Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad Smt Antara Sarkar Deb and the then President Abhoy Mission late Shyamal Deb, Members of Paschim Tripura Zilla Parishad with all other functionaries of panchayet system attended the program.

“Developing Comprehensive Services and Infra- structure for Children & Adults with Deafblindness and Multisensory Impairment in NE” – Tripura

ABHOY MISSION, in collaboration with Sense International India, started project for Children & Adults with Deafblindness & Multisensory Impairment from the month of October, 2019. Capacity building and Empowerment of Children & Adults with involvement of Community Resources is the chief purpose of the project. Direct service is being provided through i) training within the ambit & principle of special education ii) Assistive Device on the functional needs of a child iii) Coordination with different agencies with goal of taking benefit of different schemes iv) regular counseling & motivation. Support service is being provided to those individuals who cannot be brought under direct service. Indirect service is provided through i) synchronization with diverse agencies & ii) counseling & inspiration.

This year, 09 new children and 02 adults with Deafblindness were identified but at the same time we lost one child beneficiary as she expired as a result of prolonged ailing condition.

By the end of 2021-22 financial year 21 children and adult with Deafblindness were receiving direct service and 03 adults & 01 child with Deafblindness were receiving support service through the project.





State Level Training Program on Deafblindness involving SMSA Teachers

With joint effort of ABHOY MISSION and Sense International India the Tripura State level Training Program for SMSA Teachers was organized on 14th September, 2021. On request of ABHOY MISSION, the State Project Director, Samagra Siksha, Tripura, authorized Special Educators under Saksham Tripura Project and District IE Coordinators to participate in the training program. In total, 86 participants registered their name for the training program. Out of the 43 were female. Category wise division of the registered participants were such-

Participants from all the eight Districts of Tripura joined the training program. Highest number of participants from West Tripura District and least number of participants from Khowai Districts attended the program. Out of 86 registered participants, 29 belonged to tribe communities.

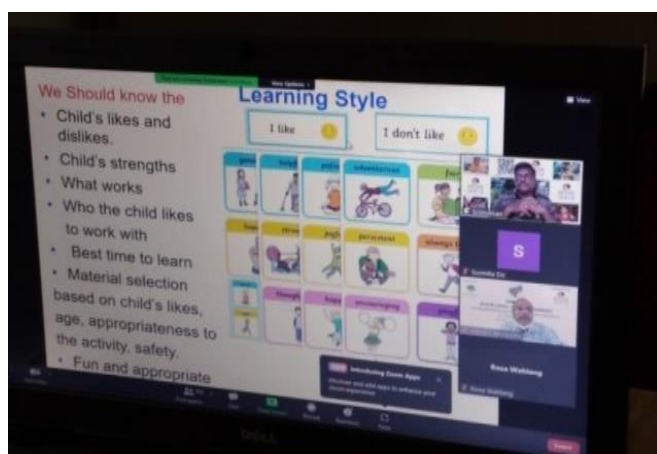
Besides Registered participants, District IE Coordinators and some officials also participated in the training program. In the first hour of the Training the number of participants rose up to 118.

The State level Training Program was started through welcome address by Dr. Abhijit Chanda, the member of Governing Body of ABHOY MISSION. In his speech Dr.

Chanda emphasized relevance of organizing this State Level Training Program particularly keeping in mind the challenges being faced in providing equitable inclusive opportunities to Deafblind children in regular schools. Sri Schin Rizal, Head- Capacity Building, Sense International India commenced his discussion with history of development of Deafblind movement in India, establishment and contribution of different organizations in this movement. He also elaborated how projects for empowerment of deafblind adults and children are supported by Sense International India in coordination with 23 partner organizations in India. He told that 05 Deafblind Regional Centers and number of Deafblind State Centers are operational for empowerment of deafblind individuals.

Sri Rashmikanth Mishra, Senior Trainer- Capacity Building, Sense International India, made detailed discussion on understanding Inclusive Education and Curricular Adaptation for Children with Deafblindness. Easy access to curriculum, structuring lessons, planning of lessons, nine types of Curriculum Adaptations were also part of his discussion. Sri Srinivasan Prasanna, Lead- Trainer- Capacity Building of Sense International India made discussion on teaching strategies for students with Deafblindness. The factors which are considered simple by many people made valuable in his discussion as essential parts of teaching strategies. He provided importance on mode of learning of Deafblind child, differences in focus for Deafblind children, priorities in the education of Deafblind child, individual learning style of each individual student and asked participants to provide value to likings and disliking, strength of each child, preference to specific person, time and environment. His discussion provided significance to use of materials, suitable environment and meaningful activities for the purpose of learning by a student with Deafblindness.

Interaction between participants and resource persons in Question and Answer session lasted for 20 minutes of time. The program was concluded with Vote of Thanks from Dr. P.N. Dey, Member of Governing Body of ABHOY MISSION. The participants, who submitted answer to post test questions online, awarded e-certificate for participation in the State Level Training Program on Deafblindness.



Tripura State Level Network Meeting

An online State Level Network Meeting involving parents and family members of Deafblind individuals was held by ABHOY MISSION with support from Sense International India and H T Parekh Foundation on the 26th August, 2021. The meeting aimed to strengthen local Networks, specially the Network of parents and family members for inclusion of persons with Deafblindness. Parents, family members, Deafblind State Centre Team and officials of ABHOY MISSION and Sense International India interacted with each other in the meeting.

The Meeting was started at 01:00 pm. Sri Nirmal Deb, President of ABHOY MISSION, Agartala, Tripura provided an outline of the Local Networks of parents and family members of Tripura State.

In the Technical Session, Sudip Datta, from ABHOY MISSION, made a short discussion on aims and objective of Network Meeting. Then Network Status update was given by Ms Nikita Modi, Networks Officer, Sense International India. She told that Sense International India is supporting three National Networks, namely, **Udaan** for adult deafblinds, **Prayaas** for parents and family members of Deafblind individual and **Abhi-Prerna** For Special Educators providing service to Deafblind children and shared information on these networks. Shrutilata Singh from Sense India made discussion on role of Networks in Advocacy. She told that deafblinds and their family members are to get nothing if they remain silent. They should raise our voice together to achieve something.

Among the parents & family members, Smt Chunita Karmakar, sister of a deafblind boy with spastic paraplegia emphasized the need of physiotherapeutic intervention for her brother as the family fears onset of deformity in his body. Sri Uttam Saha, father of Chandra shekhar Saha raise issue of support to adult deafblind from financial point of view. Papri Roy Biswas, sister of an adult deafblind girl, shared the experience and challenges faced by the family members on the route to the inclusion of their deafblind family member.

Tripura State Level Advocacy Meeting for Deafblind Inclusion

ABHOY MISSION with support from Sense International India and H T Parekh Foundation organized the online State Advocacy Meeting for deafblind inclusion, today on the 27th of August, 2021. The meeting aimed to converge with initiatives of relevant State Government Departments, and civil society organizations for inclusion of persons with deafblindness. Parents, special educators and persons with deafblindness interacted with government officials on a common platform to find solution for the rehabilitation needs of persons with deafblindness. The program commenced with condolence

observation of late Shyamal Deb, the founder President of ABHOY MISSION. In Key note address, Sri Akhil Paul, Executive Director of Sense International India, recalled the memory of late Shyamal Deb. He also gave an account of partnership between Sense International India and ABHOY MISSION. Sri Achintam Killikder, Deputy Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities, Tripura, stated that role of NGOs in the field of empowerment of individuals with disabilities is growing in Tripura State. He also mentioned about limited availability of Special Educators, professionals and fund for the disability area in the State. He pledged for help, cooperation from State Government as well as Social Welfare Department to the project for deafblind and MSI persons.

Mr. Seababrata De, Assistant Director I/C of NCSC-DA narrated facilities being provided by their Institution for the purpose of vocational training. 03 District Inclusive Education Coordinators, namely, Madhumita Majumder, Satyajit Manik, Prashanta Debnath briefed the facilities being provided to the children with disabilities enrolled in school.

DDRC Dhalai, DISE, khowai, DISE, Dhalai, State I/E Coordinator, Govt. Of Tripura and Hon'ble Sabhadhipati of Paschim Tripura Zila Parishad also participated in the meeting.

Ms Shrutilata Singh of Sense India made discussion on Deafblind rights and responsibilities. Existence of contradiction between Rights of Deafblind persons and responsibilities of different sections of the community, Reservation quota versus actual employment opportunity, availability of system versus inaccessibility, Acquisition of independence versus existence of barriers and communication gap surfaced in her speech.

Among the parents Smt. Mourina Chakraborty, mother of Miss Camellia chakraborty , shared her experience first. Camellia is an Artist and pursuing Master Degree in Fine Arts. Smt. Mourina Chakraborty Chakraborty sought help regarding marketing of creative art of Camellia and her financial security in future. Tapan Bhowmik, father of Tiyaasha Bhowmik, a 17 years old girl suffering from deafblindness along with autism and ADHD, told in his statement that providing education was far easier in her childhood and the process of providing education becomes gradually difficult as she is growing now. He also told that he is finding no safe area for Tiyaasha for few days as he or His wife might have to go the outside state for medical intervention. Sri Uttam Kumar Saha, father of Sri Chandrashekhar Saha, an adult deafblind with profound mental retardation, to that he needs help for employment of Chandrashekhar in near future.

Sri Seababrata De, Assistant Director I/C of NCSC-DA, Agartala, requested the Project Coordinator to bring all Adult and young adult deafblinds to NCSC-DA, Agartala for assessment from vocational training point of view. Smt. Supriya De, Superintendent

of Swabalamban Rehabilitation Centre (CCI) for children with special needs, told that the CCI has short stay facilities so Sri Tapan Bhowmik can keep Tiyaasha there for availing short stay facilities.

Report on Tripura State Level online Training on Deafblindness for Medical and Paramedical Professionals

Tripura State Level online Training on Deafblindness for Medical and Paramedical Session was held on 10th March, 2022. More than 20 participants including Doctors, Nurse, Physiotherapists and pharmacists involve themselves in the training program. Professionals from HFT Nursing Institute, ITI Road, Agartala and Anandanagar PHC also participated in the program. The Training program was graced by the presence of Hon'ble Sabhadhipati of Paschim Tripura Zila Parishad, Smt. Antara Sarkar Deb.

Inaugural session was commenced by the welcome address from Hon'ble President of ABHOY MISION, Sri Nirmal Deb. In his address, Sri Nirmal Deb highlighted the functioning of Deafblind State Centre in Tripura State and potential vital role of medical and paramedical professionals in early identification, assessment early intervention for children with Deafblindness as well as rehabilitation of persons with disabilities.

In his address to participants, Sri Sachin Rizal, Head- Capacity Building of Sense International India, told that in Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, Deafblindness has been included under the category of Multiple Disabilities. Though proper certification helps in getting proper rehabilitation measures, still in India, receiving certificate for deafblindness is a much more difficult experience- he told. He requested the participant professionals to provide more attention to screening and assessment of persons with deafblindness topic of discussion.

The program was inaugurated by the Secretary of ABHOY MISSION, Miss Susmita De. In her speech, she recalled the joint venture of ABHOY MISSION and Sense International India in service of Deafblind persons in Tripura.

In the technical session, at first, Sri P. Sinivasan, Lead Trainer- Capacity Building, Sense International India, made discussion on characteristics of deafblindness, uniqueness of deafblindness, types, causes and prevention of deafblindness.

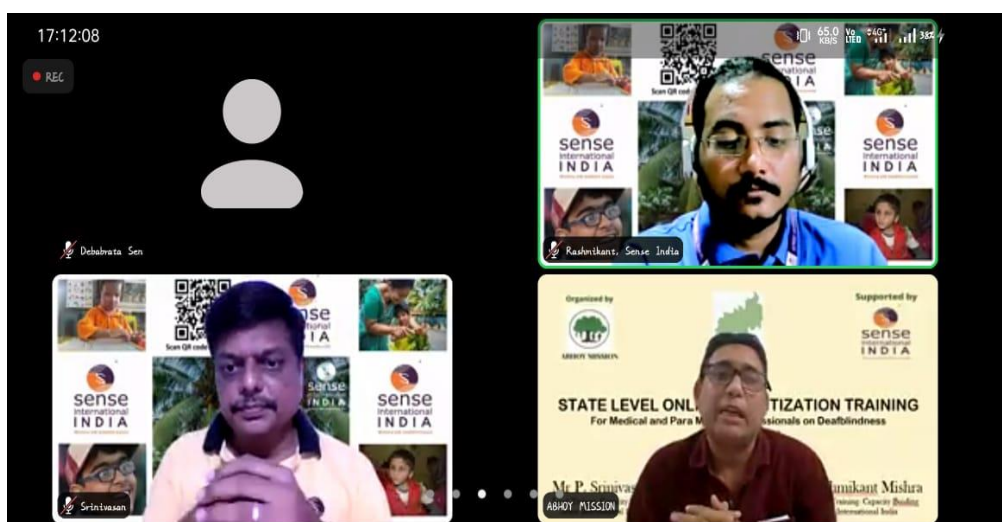
In the questions-answer on the topic Dr. Nilratan Majumder, Child Specialist, said the training program has immense value because Deafblind persons are not taken up properly for identification, assessment and rehabilitation by medical professionals in Tripura till date. Awareness program even for specialists Doctors are necessary – he told. Dr. Prabir Saha, HOD, Department Otorhinolaryngology, Tripura Medical College and BRAM Hospital also emphasized the need of organizing such training program on Deafblind issues.



Sri Parag Namdeo, Head- Network Support of Sense International India, made discussion on barriers as per Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, barrier as impact of COVID 19 before persons with disabilities, persons with deafblindness as persons with high support needs, Early Identification and Early Intervention program. He told that Early intervention program is still non-existent in many Health Institutions in India.

In question- answer session Dr. Anita Das of Agartala Medical Govt. Medical College, raised the requirement of proper education for such children/ persons with disabilities Rashmikanth Mishra, Senior Trainer- Capacity Building, Sense international India, made discussion on screening and assessment. Important considerations during assessment, environmental context during assessment and assessment for multisensory deficit came to the surface in his discussion.

In Vote of thanks, Dr. Abhijit Chanda, Member of Governing Body of ABHOY MISSION, provided thanks to all participant professionals, resource persons, delegates of Sense International India and their contribution to make the program successful.



Counseling

We make counseling to parents regularly so that they can extend support to their children, on the basis of each child's individual need and current level of performance. Even after counseling, we extend our institution based physiotherapy support to children if found necessary.

School Readiness Programme

Hard work is being done to inspire the parents & family members to take their children with special need to Anganwadi centre or Nursery schools or in Special schools to make smooth the progress of readiness programme. We arrange Care Givers to develop children with special needs for regular schooling.

Different programs in Abhoy Ashram, Old Age Home & Swabalamban Rehabilitation Centre for Children with Spl. Needs, Chaitra Sankranti 1427 & Bengali New Year, 1428

In Chaitra Sankranti on 14th April, various sweet dishes were made along with a special special boiled mix vegetable dish with name "Pachan" by the initiatives of elderly in Ashram. The very next day was Bengali New Year which is very much auspicious for Bengali community. In this day a puja was prepared at temple where old person and children came by wearing new clothes.
